Born in Essex, **Matthew Elderton-Lewis** (b. 2001) is a composer whose music has been workshopped and performed by Ligeti Quartet, Phacelia Ensemble, Riot Ensemble, Chroma Ensemble, harpist Catrin Finch, Bethan Conway, flautist Carla Rees, Belle Quartet and the collegiate Royal Holloway Chapel Choir. With his style being described as both idiosyncratic and memorably melodic, Matthew began gaining recognition after being awarded the 'MMus Prize for Outstanding Achievement' for his postgraduate degree. He is also a multimedia composer and has written music for several adverts, trailers and short films.
